Know your rights

You don't need a bib to be on the race course. It is illegal for AEG or the police to prevent you from entering any street or sidewalk. According to the City of San Francisco (ISCOTT).

Police search: Do not consent to a police search. The Fourth Amendment protects against unreasonable searches and seizures. Don't give police a reason to search you, and then they can't. If they ask, just say NO, politely.

Alcohol: Drinking in public is not an arrestable offense. It is punishable only by confiscation and/or fine.

Sobering tents: In order for them to qualify under California law as a legal treatment facility, they must be open for at least 72 hours and certified by the state. Neither is true of these "tents". If the police take you to a sobering tent, call a lawyer. In order to be taken into protective custody (a drunk tank), a person must be "unable to exercise care for his or her own safety or the safety of others."
